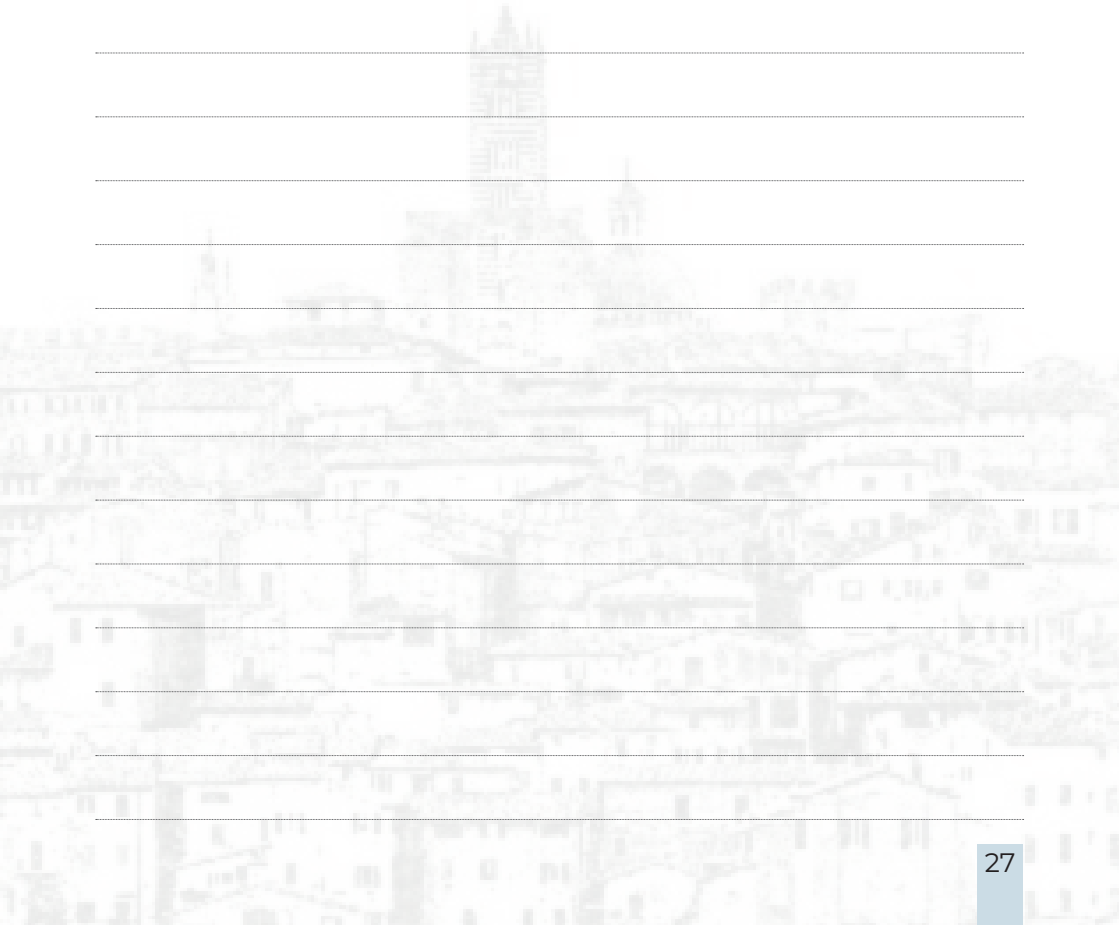
Participation certificates will be released on September 9th to all the registered participants from the Secretariat when required.
